 2. Team Banner – optional. Up to the team if they want to do it and what style to use.

 3. Pictures. Images Photography will attend Opening Day and will take individual and team pictures. Each team is assigned a time in advance. Forms will be handed out today and will also be available Opening Day.
 4. Activities.

 - Snacks. Post game snacks are optional.
 - Sponsors – each team needs to have a sponsor. The cost is \$350 which is used to help defray uniform costs. In exchange for the donation, the sponsor will receive their company name on the back of the jersey, acknowledgment on the WSLLL website, and a team picture plaque. WSLLL is a 501c non-profit organization. For an additional \$25, the players' names can be put on the back of the jersey instead of the sponsor name. If a team doesn't obtain a sponsor, then the team's parents will be asked to sponsor the team.
